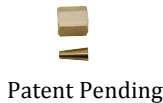

## Wire Stop compared to a traditional terminal hardware Using 3/8<sup>th</sup> EHS strand

Size	1.25 inches	Over 3 feet
Weight	2.3 ounces	1 pound 11 ounces
Strength	As strong as strand. Strand breaks in pull tests before ends fail	Limited to weakest part 5/8" lags are rated at only 5,200 lbs. breaking strength
Wear	No metal rubbing against metal	Thimble or wire wrap can wear against hook or eye
Hole size in tree	7/16th using 3/8th EHS	3/4 <sup>th</sup> using 5/8 <sup>th</sup> eye or lag
Number of parts per end	2	5
Ease of Application	2-3 minutes to fix one end	10 minutes or more per end
Versatility of Application	Can be used on crotches that actually meet	Must have a 6 feet between parts to be cabled
Finished appearance	No hardware between limbs Wire stop extends 1.25" on back side of limb	Extends over 2.5 feet on inside of either limb then extends out of backside as well.
